NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY – Cornerstone Family Violence Prevention Centre (Cornerstone) is pleased to announce it has completed the facility updates 100+ Women With Heart, the Northumberland chapter of 100 Women Who Care, funded last month.

Committed to making a difference within their community, 100 Women With Heart saw the need to further improve the quality of Cornerstone’s facilities and gifted a \$6,800 grant to make the rejuvenation project possible.
