

GENERAL RULES

- Only 750 tickets will be printed. There will be one (1) main prize draw to be awarded. Tickets are not tax deductible.
- The odds of winning will depend on the number of tickets sold. All inquiries, if any, on the "odds of winning" are to be made to the licensee prior to the purchase of a ticket.
- The total combined value of all prizes is CDN \$10,000.00.
- All winning tickets will be drawn publicly at Cornerstone Family Violence Prevention Centre at 40 Swayne Street in Cobourg.
- The draw will commence on June 28, 2021 at 10:00 AM and will conclude when the winning ticket has been drawn. To be eligible for the draw, tickets must be purchased by midnight June 21, 2021.
- The Lottery Draw sequence is set out on the back of all tickets.
- After the winning ticket stub is drawn, a photocopy is made of the stub (including ticket number), and prize is recorded.
- The drum shall be rotated a minimum of 3 times before a stub is drawn.
- Should you have any questions on the procedures of the draw, please contact Carly Cunningham, Cornerstone Family Violence Prevention Centre, before purchasing your ticket.
- Cornerstone's Hope Grows Lottery ticket prize must be accepted as awarded.
- The prize must be claimed within 45 days of the draw.
- The prize will be awarded in Canadian Dollars
- The winning number will be posted at www.cornerstonenorthumberland.ca/lottery, on Cornerstone's Social Media Networks, and at Cornerstone Family Violence Prevention Centre.
- The winner will be notified by phone, mail or in person and given complete instructions on how to redeem their winning prize.
- The winner must agree to the use of their name and likeness for publicity purposes by Cornerstone Family Violence Prevention Centre Lottery.
- The liability of the licensee of this lottery shall be limited to the purchase price of the ticket.
- Ticket purchasers must be a minimum of 18 years of age. Tickets cannot be purchased in the name of a person less than 18 years of age.
- Tickets must be both sold and purchased in the Province of Ontario. While physically in Ontario, residents of other countries or provinces may purchase raffle tickets sold under a licence issued in Ontario.
- Postdated cheques cannot be accepted as payment for the purchase of tickets.
- The licensee shall validate all tickets submitted for the draw; under no circumstances will unpaid or ineligible tickets be entered into the draw.
- Charitable registration number is 11930 2289 RR0001.
- Personal information provided by purchaser is used solely by Cornerstone Family Violence Prevention Centre & Lottery.
- The following persons are prohibited from purchasing tickets in Cornerstone's Hope Grows Lottery (Pursuant to AGCO Regulations): Cornerstone Board of Directors, employees of Cornerstone Family Violence Prevention Centre, including their immediate families living at the same residence., Business owners, or management at any of the supporting organizations, including their immediate families living at the same residence
- All 3-pack tickets must contain the same name and mailing address on each ticket stub.
- The prize will be awarded to the Ticket Holder named on the ticket stub.
- In the case of shared tickets, it will be the responsibility of the Ticket Holder to allocate the prize as necessary.
